We offer free support and consultation on behalf of the classroom (or in-home childcare) or on an individual child aged 0-8 throughout Larimer County.

Classroom consultation

- Observation
- Assess for classroom strengths and areas for growth, concentrating on social and emotional skill building
- Individual teacher support and consultation

Child specific consultation

- Observation of children with behavioral challenges
- Collaboration with teachers to develop a behavioral support plan
- Family support, consultation, and collaboration, including meetings with parents, schools or outside providers
- Referrals for additional supports including behavioral health therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech, and community resources
